Upon arrival of Hwy 98 & Marine Street you will receive booth assignment and map.

No changing booth assignments. Booth space is 10 x 12.

Vendors must provide all necessary equipment their booths.

Vendors are also responsible for having all required government licenses and to meet all health and safety requirements.

All tents and shelters must be secured by weights by the start of the festival. Booths are on pavement.

If you indicated on your application you have power needs a festival representative will assist.

The booth fee must be paid on or before the assignment of the booth and is **not refundable** for any reason.

Traffic is one way down Marine Street from Hwy 98 because of the narrowness of the streets. This will allow for setting up & dismantling booths. Please make sure your booth set-up does not impair the road

driving lanes to allow for emergency vehicles.

All vehicles must be parked in the designated parking area by 9:45a.m., unless prior arrangements have been made.

These rules are in place for both safety and efficiency for everyone involved. Violators will be required to take immediate corrective action.

Festival hours are 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. Please plan to keep your booth open the entire time from 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m. Breakdown booth after 6:00 p.m.
