

The Carrabelle Area Chamber of Commerce together with the City of Carrabelle invites you to join us for the annual Boat Parade of Lights which is open to anyone who wants to participate. We hope you will join us for a favorite holiday event for Carrabelle and the Forgotten Coast.

There is no entry fee to participate in the Boat Parade of Lights!

All vessels excluding paddled vessels will be in size categories.

The boat parade takes a circular course on the Carrabelle River which begins at the Old Flour Docks at the end of Marine Street, continues up the river to Tillie Miller Bridge, and then turns downriver to return to the starting point. Line up for the Parade will be at 6:15 pm with a starting time just after dark.

Boat captains are required to attend a meeting where they will receive their boat entry number and instructions for line-up.
